**PUBLIC NOTICE FOR THE APPOINTMENT ON THE POST OF MEMBER  
(ENGINEERING) IN JHARKHAND STATE ELECTRICITY REGULATORY  
COMMISSION**

**Advertisement No. -01/JSERC(E)/2015**

The Jharkhand State Electricity Regulatory Commission (JSERC) had been set up by the Government of Jharkhand at Ranchi under the provisions of the Electricity Act. The Commission consists of the Chairperson and two other Members. One post of Member (Engineering), JSERC is vacant for which applications are invited.

Appointment to the post of Member, JSERC is governed by the relevant provisions of the Electricity Act and the Jharkhand State Electricity Regulatory Commission (Salary, allowances and other conditions of service of Chairperson and Members) Rules 2010, as may be amended from time to time.

Section 84 of the Electricity Act 2003 inter alia states that, the Member of the State Commission shall be person of ability, integrity and understanding who have adequate knowledge of, and have shown capacity in, dealing with problems relating to finance, commerce, economics, law or management. It has further been prescribed that the Member of the State Commission shall not hold any other office. The candidate will have to give a declaration that he/she does not have any financial or other interest, which is likely to affect prejudicially his/her functions as Member (Engineering), Jharkhand State Electricity Regulatory Commission.

The terms of appointment shall be in accordance with the provisions of Letter No. 3/6/97 (Estt. Pay-II) Dated 29<sup>th</sup> January, 1998 issued by Ministry of Personnel Public Grievances and Pensions Department of Personnel & Training, Govt. of India where in it has been indicated that the Chairperson and Member(s) shall be deemed to have retired from Govt. service upon taking up their respective appointments in the Regulatory Authority.

In terms of section 89 of the Act, the Member shall hold office for a term of five years from the date on which he/ she enters upon his/ her office or till he/ she attains the age of sixty-five years, whichever is earlier. The candidate is required to give a declaration that he/she does not have any financial or other interest, which is likely to affect prejudicially his/her function as Member (Engineering), JSERC.

The applicant who is in service, must submit an undertaking from his/her employer that they would have no objection in relieving him/her in case he/she is offered appointment.

Applications are invited in the enclosed prescribed format from suitable persons having qualification and experience in technical field as prescribed in the Act for appointment as member (Engineering ), JSERC so as to reach the Deputy Secretary (Energy) on the address below on or before **30.04.2015** by Speed Post.
