1. The applicant shall have not less than 05 (five) drilling machines each having capacity to drill more than 300 m of depth.
2. The applicant must have capacity of doing 100 meter of drilling in a day.
3. This is the responsibility of the applicant to present documentary proof regarding human resources and machines in front of technical committee. Any wrong information furnished by the applicant will be considered as disqualification.

SECTION – V
Work Specification

- i) Inclined/ vertical (as required in the field condition) Diamond core drilling in HQ/NQ/BQ size in hard/soft and very soft rock formation and dry drilling in Bauxite area.
- ii) Borehole deviation and corrections must be applied for interpreting surface geology.
- iii) All the bore hole should be logged properly and the original log should be preserved in Wooden/Aluminum boxes.
- iv) Core recovered from drilling shall be geologically logged and packed in core boxes supplied by drilling agency with proper labeling.
- v) The driller's log shall be maintained properly with run wise core/sludge recovery, Lithological detail and any other observation if any.
- vi) The driller's log should also be kept in readiness for inspection.
- vii) The decision for closure of any borehole shall be taken by the authorized representative of the Directorate of Geology, Department of Mines and Geology, Ranchi.
- viii) Other specifications as required from time to time in course of drilling shall be complied with.
- ix) Lithological and Digital Graphical log of core shall be prepared on specified scale.

SECTION – VI

Scope of Work

Responsibilities of Applicant:

1. The applicant will have to do proper packaging of the core obtained from drilling and dispatch them to State Geological Laboratory, Hazaribagh.
2. The applicant will have to make all arrangements at their own for drilling, boarding & lodging and other logistic support for their members.
3. The applicant shall make all arrangements like site preparation, watch and ward, mobilization of rig and equipment adjustment with local environment etc. for drilling at drilling site.
4. The applicant shall have to preserve the core in core boxes which will be handed over to Directorate of Geology whenever directed to do so.
5. The applicant shall give undertakings towards the security and confidentiality of inputs and final data products generated in the course of drilling. They shall not use these input and output for any other purpose. All the field documentation and maps used for drilling shall be handed over to Directorate of Geology after completion of the work.

Starting of work by Applicant:-

1. The applicant shall start the drilling work on the site within a week after getting the work order with at least one rig.
2. In the first phase, drilling work shall be started with at least two diamond drilling rigs.
3. In the second phase (after one week of first phase) two additional drilling rigs shall start operating and likewise number of drilling rigs will go on for the third, fourth & further phases of drilling.

Duration of Contract and Agreement

An Agreement will be signed by applicant and Directorate of Geology explaining all terms and condition applicable during the valid period of three years.

SECTION – VII

General Terms & Conditions

Applicant have to give presentation of their work done earlier, procedure and experience certificate of performance related to Wet drilling in Iron & Manganese, Limestone, Graphite, Pyroxenite etc. and Dry drilling in Bauxite before the Technical Committee on the informed date.

1. The date of Technical presentation will be informed later.
2. Selected Applicant will be asked for submission of Financial Bid on the later stage.
3. The empanelment will be valid for three years from the date of communication to the successful firms who had deposited the security money as mentioned below:-
4. Security Deposit:

The selected firms will be required to deposit an amount of Rs. 5,00,000/- (Rupess Five Lakh only) in the form of Bank Guarantee issued by any Nationalized/Schedule bank in favour of **Director, Geology, Department of Industry, Mines & Geology, Government of Jharkhand, Ranchi.**

The firm/firms shall renew the Security deposit on periodic basis till the empanelment period is not over.

In case of deviation of agreed terms & conditions by the firm/firms the Bank Guarantee shall be encashed.

Incase the firm/firms want(s) to withdraw themselves from the Empanelment list, the security deposit may be refunded to the firm/firms after deducting receivables of DMG, Jharkhand if any.

Non completion of assigned job/work shall lead to forfeit of security deposit and the same shall be encashed.

Provided that if the situation at the work site is proved to be beyond the control of the agency/firm (force majeure) than the same shall be acceptable by the competent authority and the security deposit shall not be forfeited. The decision of the Principal Secretary, Mines & Geology Department shall be final in this regard.

5. DMG, Jharkhand will evolve a rate contract through invitation of offers/tenders from empanelled vendors.
6. Work shall be distributed to vendors/among vendors depending upon their capabilities and the requirement of the Department. The decision of DMG, Jharkhand in this regard shall be final. However, for execution of any complex project, DMG, Jharkhand will select and invite firms form the empanelled list based on their suitability and capability matching the scope of the same project to participate in the tender for the project. The techno-commercial bids of the selected empanelled firms will be evaluated by the technical as well purchase committee of DMG, Jharkhand. The work shall be allotted to the firm/firms whose price is lowest in the tender offer.
7. DMG, Jharkhand reserves the right to execute the job-work through any other firm/firms of its choice in case of acute emergencies/non-completion of the work by the previous allottee/other reasons etc.
8. All disputes shall be settled within the territorial Jurisdiction of the Court of Ranchi only.
