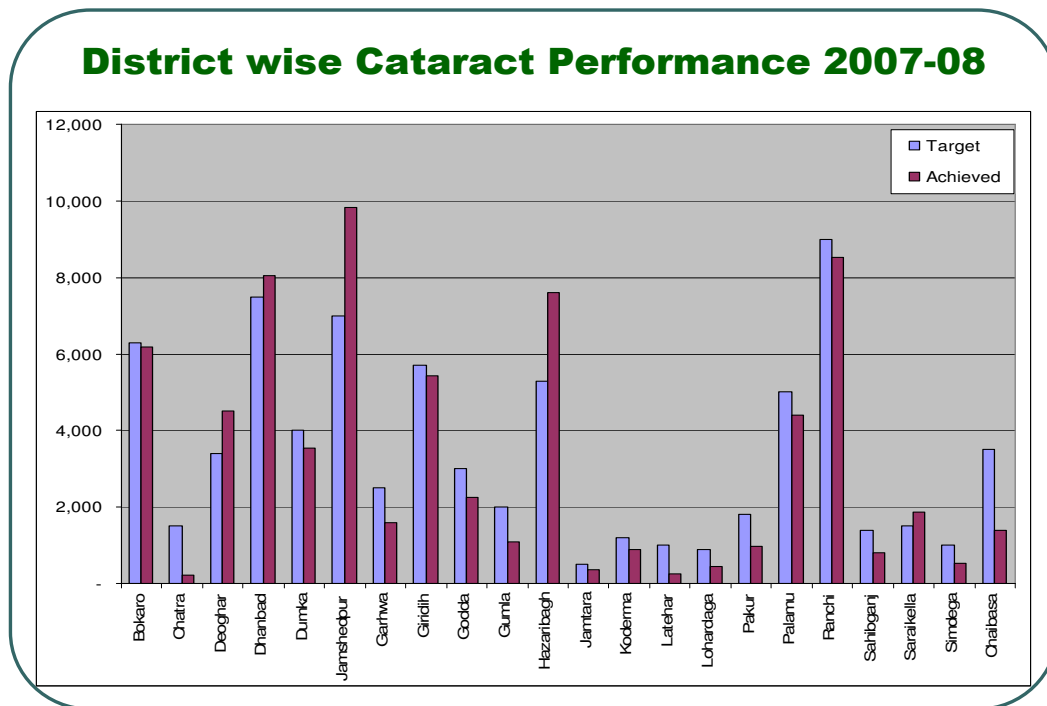

Achievement of State 70659/ 75000 (94.10%) 90% of surgeries done with I.O.L implant

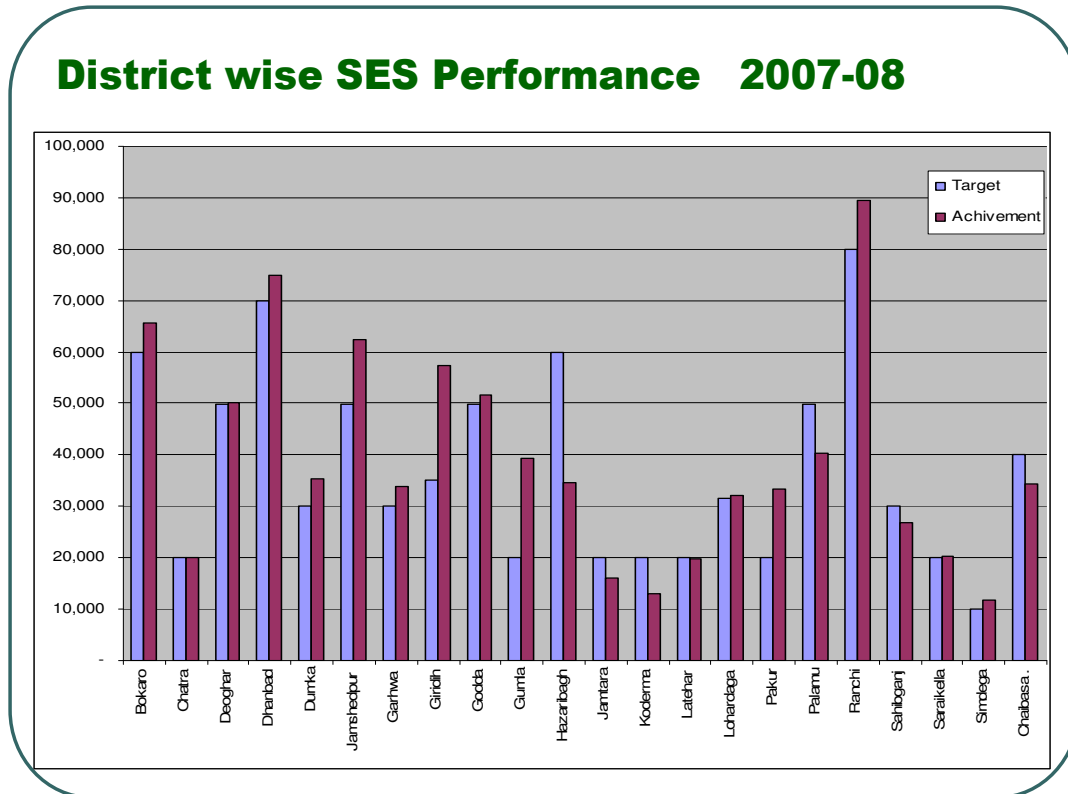
