**Sub:- Regarding full operationalization of e-FMS under MGNREGS.**

**Ref :- MoRD, GoI letter no. A-CCA/RD/UB/09-10/1(RE-1) and Department Memo. No. 1119 dated 20.02.2014**

Sir,

With reference to the above, this is to inform you that you have already been directed to operationalise e-FMS fully from 1<sup>st</sup> March, 2014 but full operationalisation is yet to happen even after repeated requests.

In order to fully operationalise e-FMS from 1st April, 2014 the following directions must be strictly adhered to -

1. All sub- district level A/C should be closed and balance amount be pulled back to e-FMS A/C.
2. No physical cheque should be issued from 1st April, 2014 for payment of wages. Accordingly DC-cum-DPC will issue standing directions to all concerned agencies. Bank/ Post offices are to be informed not to accept any physical cheque for payment of wages.
3. Material payment also needs to be made through e-FMS for which tasks of freezing of DPR, Vender details etc. are to be ensured.
4. All authorised officials at different levels, including officials of implementing agencies, must procure their DSC immediately for authorization/ approval of FTO.
5. Honorarium payment to all MGNREGA officials (on contract) should be made through e-FMS and their Aadhaar must be obtained for Aadhaar Enabled Payment transfer.
6. A daily monitoring desk headed by DDC should be put in place for regular monitoring of FTO generation, daily squaring of A/C, appropriate action on rejected/ pending FTO and other related issues.
7. If e-FMS for material payment is impossible to be implemented because of some critical pending issues then DC-cum-DPC will himself certify and authorize payment

as per instructions contained in MoRD, GoI letter no. A-CCA/RD/UB/09-10/1(RE-1) dated 17.02.2014.

You are again being requested to stop all physical cheque based payments at all levels, ensure full operationalization of e-FMS without any further delay and monitor yourself the progress regularly.

Please ensure strict compliance on the instructions contained in this letter.
