DOCUMENTS ESTABLISHING BIDDER'S ELIGIBILITY AND

QUALIFICATIONS

The tenderer shall furnish the self certified copies of following documents as part of his Tender Documents:-

A) Documents

1. The Bidder shall furnish as part of his bid an **Earnest Money Deposit** for the required amount as prescribed in Column-3 of Section – VI.

SECTION – V

WORK SPECIFICATION

- i) Incline/ vertical (as required in the field condition) Diamond core drilling in HQ/NQ/BQ size in hard/soft and very soft rock formation or dry drilling in Bauxite area.
- ii) Borehole deviation and corrections must be applied for interpreting surface geology.
- iii) All the bore hole should be logged properly and the original log should be preserved in Wooden/Aluminum boxes.
- iv) Core recovered from drilling shall be geologically logged and packed in core boxes supplied by drilling agency with proper labeling.
- v) Sludge recovered from drilling shall be packed in polythene tubes immediately after geological logging and packed in core boxes with proper labeling of borehole numbers and depths till the end of exploration for laboratory test.
- vi) The driller's log shall be maintained properly with run wise core/sludge recovery, Lithological detail and any other observation if any.
- vii) The driller's log should also be kept in readiness for inspection.
- viii) The decision for closer of any borehole shall be taken by the authorized representative of the Directorate of Geology, Department of Mines and Geology, Ranchi.
- ix) Other specifications as required from time to time in course of drilling shall be complied with.
- x) Lithological and Digital Graphical log of core shall be prepared on specified scale.
- xi) Interpretation and result of Geophysical logging shall be provided by the agency.
- xii) Aquifer condition (if any) and Ground water level shall be recorded precisely in each bore hole.

1. The Bid shall be typed or printed and the Bidder shall initial each page. The authorization to sign the Bid Document must be confirmed by a written Power of Attorney accompanying the bid.
2. Bidders would provide all the information as per this Tender Document and in the specified formats. The Tender Committee reserves the right to reject any Bid that is not in the specified formats.
3. The Bid must contain no interlineations or overwriting. If it is necessary to correct, the correction must be done by the Bidders themselves. Such corrections must be initialed by the person or persons signing.
4. Bidder must not indicate directly or indirectly their Financial Bid anywhere in the envelope of the Technical Bid. Any such disclosure shall result in summary rejection of the whole of the Bid of the concerned Bidders.

SECTION – VIII

Terms & Conditions

A) General Information for Tenderer :-

1. The *TENDER* and the *BIDDERS*, are synonymous and shall include his/her legal successors or assignees as well.
2. The Purchase Committee shall open the bids in the presence of bidders or their authorized representatives who choose to attend on due date and time. The bidder's representatives who are present, shall sign an attendance sheet. The bidder shall submit authority letter to this effect before they are allowed to participate in the bid opening.
3. Only one representative for any bidder shall be authorized and permitted to attend the bid opening.
4. The Tenderer will be bound by all the terms, conditions and specifications as detailed in the tender document.
5. Any person employed in this department will not be allowed to participate in this Tender before completion of two years after his/her retirement.
6. The Tenderer shall provide all the informations as per Tender Document.
7. No modification by tenderer in any of the conditions will be permitted before or after the tender is submitted or opened.
8. The Tender Document is not transferable.
9. Under no circumstances for any delay in payment to the tenderer, any claims will be considered.
10. No advance payment will be given for the work.
11. In the event, the tender does not materialize for any reason whatsoever, the Directorate of Geology will have the right to terminate the tender without obligations and the earnest money will be refunded without any interest.
12. Director, Geology reserves the right to reject any or all the tender bids without assigning any reason whatsoever and is not bound to accept the lowest tender.
13. All disputes shall be settled within the territorial Jurisdiction of the Court of Ranchi only.

14. At any time before the due date of submission of the Bids, the Purchase Committee may for any reasons whatsoever, at its own initiative or in response to a clarification requested by the Bidders, modify the Tender Document by amendment.
15. Volume of the work will be assigned to successful tenderer by Director of Geology Department of Mines & Geology, Ranchi.

B) General Terms for Tenderer :-

16. The rate quoted must be composite rate including all the taxes.
17. The tenderer shall not assign, sub contract or sub let the whole or any part of the work covered by the tender under any circumstances.

C) Experience and Technical Human Resources:-

18. The tenderer shall have experience of diamond core drilling and exploration in Iron Ore, Lime stone, Manganese, Pyroxenite, Graphite and Bauxite or other mineral bearing formations.
19. The tenderer shall have not less than 10 drilling machines each having capacity to drill more than 300 mts. The tenderer should have experience of a minimum of 50,000 meterage of core drilling in a year for minerals indicated in this NIT. (Supported by proof).
20. The tenderer must have sufficient number of accessories for drilling machines and skilled human resources i.e. Geologist, Geophysicist, Drilling Engineer, Machine Operator etc. for drilling operation (Supported by proof and CV of Human Resource).
21. The tenderer must have experience 100 mts of drilling in one in a day (Supported by proof).
22. The tenderer must furnish details of drilling rigs in the following manner :-

23. Tenderer must have completed at least two work order of drilling for Iron Ore, Lime stone, Manganese, Pyroxenite, Graphite and Bauxite each and submit copies of work order and completion certificate as proof.
24. The tenderer must have annual turnover of more than Rs. 25 crore.

D) Responsibilities of Tenderer:

25. The tenderer will have to do proper packaging of the core obtained from drilling and dispatch them to State Geological Laboratory, Hazaribagh.

26. The tenderer will have to make all arrangements at their own for drilling, boarding & lodging and other logistic supports for their members.
27. The tenderer shall make all arrangements like site preparation, watch and ward, mobilization of rig and equipment adjustment with local environment etc. for drilling at drilling site.
28. The tenderer shall have to preserve the core in core boxes which will be handed over to Directorate of Geology whenever directed to do so.
29. The tenderer shall give undertakings towards the security and confidentiality of inputs and final data products generated in the course of drilling. They shall not use these input and output for any other purpose. All the field documentation and maps used for drilling shall be handed over to Directorate of Geology after completion of the work.

E) Starting of work by tenderer:-

30. The tenderer shall start the drilling work on the site within a week after getting the work order with at least one rig.
31. In the first phase, drilling work shall be started with at least two diamond drilling rigs.
32. In the second phase (after one week of first phase) two additional drilling rigs shall start operating and likewise number of drilling rigs will go on for the third, fourth & further phases of drilling.

F) Payment

33. The tenderer shall submit monthly bill for the work carried out in every 30 days.
34. The officers of the Directorate of Geology working at site shall physically verify all the measurements of core logs and geophysical logs of the drilling carried out in those thirty days in accordance with relevant work specifications. This verification will be completed within ten days. The verified bill will be sent to Director, Geology.

G) Duration of Contract and Agreement

An Agreement will be signed by bidder and Directorate of Geology explaining all terms and condition applicable during the valid period of three years.
